

- 2. What is the message/tone of the song?




<u>Gangsta Rap</u>

Socially Conscious Hip Hop

- A style of hip hop that emphasizes the "gangsta" lifestyle.
 - Profanity
 - Lyrics/imagery about gun-toting young men and inner city violence





- Style of hip hop made with the goal to:
 - o <u>inspire positivity</u>
 - challenge norms
